Second Chance Foods is founded and immediately begins rescuing food.

Program partnerships expand as the need for our unique services becomes clear. In partnership with CCE Putnam, our Bountiful Meals program was launched in senior centers, expanding access points to distribute healthy meals without barriers. Our staff expanded to six employees, significantly increasing our capacity and impact.




